

**Worship Date** January 10, 2010  
**Worship Theme** Listen to God's Voice  
**Scripture Reference** Psalm 29

**Materials:** Different ways to make noise with your voice, i.e. kazoo, microphone, whisper. Ask a couple of parents before church if they will call their child's name out during the story when after you ask the question, "Do you know their voice when they call?" Maybe have kazoos for each child as a reminder of story.

All people have things about them that are unique. No one has a fingerprint like yours, everyone has a different set of eyes and we all have a different way of making noise. How do we make noise? ( Listen for responses.) If no one says talking or voice or singing, ask them what about our voices?

We use our voice to communicate or talk with each other, to sing, to get people's attention. (Pull out different noise makers and talk thru them. Ask the kids to talk about how each one was a different way to talk but was all the same voice.) How do your parents get your attention? Do you know their voice when they call? After parents call child's name, point out how even when we aren't listening for parents to call us, we recognize their voice when they do call our name. Compare this to God calling His children, us, when He wants to talk to us. Ask how God tries to communicate with us. (Preacher, Bible, parents, teachers, nature, conscience) Does it make us feel happy when we hear His voice? Ask the kids when they have heard God's voice and how they responded.

Finish with a prayer asking God to help us hear His voice no matter what form it comes in.
